Mission EmployAble are delighted to be working in partnership with Buckinghamshire College Group to offer a Supported Internship programme which runs annually from September to July.

- ✓ They are 19-25 years old with an active EHCP.
- ✓ They can travel independently by bus, train or SEND taxi from Herts, Bucks and beyond.
- ✓ They are young people with learning disabilities who are keen to develop new skills in the workplace.
- ✓ They would like a paid job.

Mission EmployAble is determined to help young people with learning disabilities lead fulfilled lives and we believe that supporting our interns to find paid employment is a crucial part of

that mission. Our vision is to give them the independence and self-confidence that will help them to find paid work after their internship, so that they feel valued by their community.

All the young people (19-25yrs) who have successfully completed a year-long supported internship with Mission EmployAble will have functional English and Maths and will have been given the practical and social skills needed for a variety of jobs, including hospitality and

catering, outdoor work, retail, care homes and offices. Our programme is accredited by Bucks College Group. We continue to support our interns in their paid employment and also offer our full support to their employers.
